General Information

Our Complex has **locked** gates. These will be **open from 6.00am** by our Parking Attendants. No admittance to the grounds will be permitted prior to this.

Parking is available within the complex, with two entrances available (Wellgate Avenue and Swift Parrot Close). Please follow the directions of the parking attendants on duty. Street parking is available surrounding the complex, but please be respectful of our neighbours and keep noise to a minimum when waiting, entering, and exiting the complex. Please **do not** block driveway access or park on nature strips.

Coaches and buses must enter and exit through Wellgate Avenue. Please follow the Traffic Controllers directions to set down/pick up safely, and where to park for the duration of the day.

First Game will commence at 8:30am. Last game will finish at 3:30pm

In case of **adverse weather conditions**, any pertinent information will be available on our Facebook and Instagram pages. Otherwise, assume the carnival will go ahead as scheduled.

One Representative from each Association should attend the Administration Building from **7.30am to confirm the attendance** of all teams and be notified of any draw adjustments.

Player Tent Allocations will be forwarded to all Associations prior to Sunday. Assistance will be provided to locate each allocated area. Parent/other tents are allowed on the other grass areas of the complex. Tents **are not** allowed within the permanent Gazebo Area, Garden Beds or any asphalt surfaces. All tents **must be secured** in case of wind.

Carnival Rules

- Players must be registered members of NNSW Ltd.
- Players shall wear the registered uniform of their Association as well as positional patches.
- No jewellery to be worn. Taping of nails, earrings and bangles is not permitted.
- Once a player has played with a team she may not play with another team on the day.
- The rules regarding substitution, injury and illness and blood will apply. No extra time is played. Rolling subs as per NNSW Titles guidelines are permitted.
- Games will be centrally timed and will commence on the half hour. The timing is 2 x 12 minute halves - with 1 minute at half time and 5 minutes between games.
- The Winning team to return score sheet to control **immediately** after the game.
- The carnival will be conducted on a point score basis. Should teams finish on equal points, the goal average will be taken into consideration to determine the winner.

Score Sheets

The entire day's scoresheets are contained in the blue baskets on all courts. At the end of each game, the winning team is to return the completed scoresheet only to the Admin Building. Leave the clipboard and remaining scoresheets in the basket for the next round.

Fixture & Results

The fixtures, game results and point score ladders for all games can be found on PlayHQ and the NetballHQ App. No paper draws will be issued.

Umpires

The umpiring format is Umpire Your Own, and each association is responsible for bringing enough umpires to cover the teams competing.

Trophies

The winners of each division will be announced as soon as possible after the games are completed. Team trophies will be presented to the winning team in each division.

First Aid

First Aid is available at the Administration Building. Baulkham Hills Netball will not be responsible for any injuries incurred. The First Aid Officer is not responsible for strapping of players.

Canteen

Full canteen facilities will be available on arrival, including BBQ and barista coffee. The canteen is located behind the Administration Building. Credit card and Eftpos facilities are available.

Rubbish

Rubbish bags will be given to each Association on registration, one for each team. Please dispose of all rubbish in the bins provided.

Complex Conditions of Entry
