UNIFORM POLICY

VERSION 1

Adopted: 20th November 2021

1. Aim

Baulkham Hills Netball (BHN) is committed to ensuring our netball community is a welcoming and inclusive environment for all players and officials regardless of race, skin colour, national origin, religion, gender, sexual orientation, age or ability. BHN believes that all participants should, as far as possible, be supported in wearing a uniform that allows them to participate in netball in the manner in which they feel most comfortable.

2. Winter Competition

- a) All Club Uniforms must be approved by the BHN Executive prior to adoption by Clubs
- b) Uniforms may consist of any combination of dress, skirt, shorts & tops, so long as the design of the uniform is consistent
- c) Players in any one team may play in a mixed combination of the approved Club uniform
- d) A dress/skirt option must include a full brief as part of the uniform. This may or may not include the Club design and/or logo
- e) Each individual item must be in the same Club colours and each item must clearly display the Clubs design and/or logo
- f) All players must compete in the approved playing uniform of their Club. Any individualised variation to Club uniform (other than clause 2.g below) must be approved in writing from BHN Executive.
- g) Uniform exception permits players to wear plain black leggings and/or plain black long-sleeved tops **under** their uniform
- h) All members of a team must play in identical playing patches
- i) NO safety pins are to be used to attach playing patches to uniforms
- j) Where Clubs of similar uniform colours and design are opponents on any given game, one (1) club must wear contrasting coloured playing patches. Which team wears the alternate patches shall be determined by a toss of a coin prior to the commencement of the game.

3. For All Other BHN Competitions

Players must adhere to the Uniform guidelines appropriate to that competition.
