



# SUMMER COMP

\*Game days, times & divisions will be dependent on the number of teams registered and will be finalised after entries close

## REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEES

Players and umpires are not required to be registered members of BHN or play in the BHN Winter Competition. Registration with Netball NSW is mandatory.

**Team Registration** is via PlayHQ. There is no team rego fee payable. The team contact should complete the team registration online, and the contact will be sent a link to pass on to the players to register into the team.

**Player Registration** is via PlayHQ using the link sent by the Team Contact for your team. The cost is \$50.00 per player. If you are a registered player with Netball NSW for the current year (12-month rego for winter comp completed) there is no additional cost. If not currently registered for winter comp, you will need to complete the 3-month registration option in PlayHQ. This will cost an additional \$55.00 for a senior or \$41.00 for a junior player.

**Late Registration of a player** is allowed at any time by using the same link provided to players at initial registration. The Team Contact should save this link in case late registrations are required.

**Player De-Registrations and Refunds** must be submitted on the BHN Deregistration & Refund Request Form. These must be submitted 7 days prior to start of the competition by emailing [registrar@baulkhamhillsnetball.com.au](mailto:registrar@baulkhamhillsnetball.com.au). De-Registrations submitted after this date will not be considered. Refunds will be processed after week 2 of competition.

**If you do not have a team** - you can fill in the **Individual Player EOI** and we will make every attempt to place you in a team with one that is looking for additional players

**Entries Close on 31 January 2026**

**Competition commences** on the week of 9 February 2026 (Round 1) and **finishes** on the week of 23 March 2026 (Round 7)

**Playing night - Wednesdays** for all divisions (\*subject to change if additional nights are needed)

## AGE GROUPS/ DIVISIONS

• Net Set Go 7,8,9 years • Juniors 10,11,12,13 & 14 years in year of play

Intermediates - Ladies & Mixed • 15 to 19 years in year of play

Seniors - Ladies & Mixed • 16+ years

**Composite Teams are allowed** - Teams must register into the age group of the age of the oldest player as at 31/12/2026

\*Age groups and divisions may be combined by BHN if required



## COMPETITION RULES

All games will be played over 4 quarters (12-1-12-2-12-1-12)

**Super Shot (2 points)** will apply in last 4 minutes of each quarter (while the music is playing). The Super Shot rules apply to all age groups including NSG

All IFNA Netball rules will apply with the inclusion of the BHN Rolling Substitution Rule

**NSG - 7-9 years** will play to NetSetGo rules

**No jewellery** will be worn (no taping of jewellery allowed). Nails will be short and rounded (no gloves). **This will be strictly enforced.**

## MIXED DIVISIONS - ADDITIONAL RULES

**No less than 1 and no more than 3 male players on court at the one time.**

**Each male must be in a different third of the court positional wise** - Shooting Circle (GS, GA), Mid Court (WA, C, WD), Defence Circle (GK, GD)

## BORROWING & FORFEIT GUIDELINES

A team may take the court with 5 registered players. Less than 5 will constitute a forfeit.

Borrowing of additional players is allowed. The player being borrowed must be a registered player in the night competition of that year.

The borrowed player must be registered in a team which is graded into the same or lower division than the team being borrowed into.

Any team forfeits must be submitted using the Forfeits Sheet (link below)

## TEAM REQUIREMENTS

**Uniform** - all players must play in (at least) the same-coloured tops

**Positional Patches** - the team must supply their own set of netball playing patches

**Ball** - each team must supply a properly inflated standard sized netball of the required size (size 4 for NSG & size 5 for all other age groups)

**Umpires** - each team must supply their own umpire to officiate on their game. The umpire must be suitably qualified or experienced to umpire the grade/division of the team. **Payment amount and payment method for services is the full responsibility of the team.**

**If you do not have an umpire** - ask your Club if they have any contacts you can ask, or email BHN on [admin@baulkhamhillsnetball.com.au](mailto:admin@baulkhamhillsnetball.com.au) and we will attempt to get you in contact with an umpire from our Umpire EOI list.

## COMPLEX RULES & INFORMATION

**Entrance to the Complex** - both Wellgate Ave & Swift Parrot Close entries/exits will be open each night. The carpark will be open no later than 45 minutes prior to the first timeslot. All gates will be locked 20 minutes after the conclusion of the final game

**Adverse Weather** - The BHN Adverse Weather policy will be followed. All games will be played unless otherwise advised via social media. Decisions re adverse weather will be made no later than 30 minutes prior to the first game.

**Canteen** - will be open for limited service (details provided closer to the start). Canteen will open 30 minutes prior to the first game.

**First Aid** facilities are limited. Teams should provide their own basic first aid needs. Ice will be available on request to the Admin window.



## CODES OF CONDUCT

BHN has a zero-tolerance policy towards any abuse, bullying, harassment, discrimination, victimisation and vilification of members and visitors on the complex

Every person entering the complex is subject to the Netball NSW Codes of Behaviour and the BHN Disciplinary Policy. Teams are responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their players & spectators.

To report instances of persistent poor behaviour or obtain support for umpires in such cases, send someone to the Admin Window or Umpires Room

BHN Executive reserve the right to remove any player and/or team displaying poor behaviour from the competition.

## COMMUNICATION

**Team Contact** - Each team must supply the name and the contact details of the person who will be responsible for dealing with all the communication and admin tasks for the team (usually the person who registers the team)

Notifications from BHN relating to the team will be sent to the Team Contact

Notifications relating to the Competition as a whole will be posted on the BHN socials pages, and relevant WhatsApp Group Chats

A WhatsApp Group will be created for each competition. Each Team Contact and participating umpires or other interested members should send a request to [registrar@baulkhamhillsnetball.com.au](mailto:registrar@baulkhamhillsnetball.com.au) to join the group. This Group can be used to communicate between teams, including advertising for umpires, requesting borrowing players and other related requests and comments
